- (b) BURKE, James F., scullion, age 41, U.S. citizen, 5'5" in height, 167 lbs. Engaged 9 February 1944 at Sydney to work passage to U.S. Discharged from A.T.S. vessel for drunkenness and inefficiency; missed last ship.
