The Captain of the CHILBAR reported that on April 8 at 1947, CWT, at a point eight miles north of Jupiter, four miles from shore and two miles north of the Lake Worth Gas Buoy; proceeding northward, he was involved in a collision with an unknown cargo vessel. Neither ship was showing any lights at the time of the collision. The other ship struck the subject vessel on the port side at the bridge doing considerable damage and also struck on the port side aft of midships damaging a number of plates. He then used his radio and gave his name and the ship's name and asked for a reply but received no answer. The other ship continued on its course south.
