Described as being born on 26 December, 1906 in Stuttgart, Germany, entered the United States through New York on 2 June, 1926, filed Declaration of Intention 9 July, 1928, naturalized 8 November, 1935 in Boston Federal Court, Declaration No. 210241, Certificate No. 162526, weighs 121 lbs., blue eyes and brown hair.
- 2. William FRANKS, Z-301259, Negro, presently employed aboard the "CHILOIL" as a messman denies ever being employed by the Bethlehem Hingham Shipyard. He was born 14 February, 1924 in Tampa, Florida, and is 5' 5" in height, weighs 155 lbs., has black hair, brown eyes, dark complexion. Not the same person as the William FRANKS mentioned in Paragraph 1.
