Approving the Sale Alien and Transfer to Honduran Registry and Flag of the S/S CITY OF OMAHA

WHEREAS, An application has been filed by Lykes Brothers Steamship Company, Inc., New Orleans, Louisiana, for the approval required by Sections 9 and 37 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808 and 835), of the sale of the S/S CITY OF OMAHA, Official No. 219515, to "Albamar Sociedad de Responsabilidad Limitada", a partnership composed of Argentina citizens residing in Buenos Aires, Argentina, and the transfer of said vessel to Honduran registry and flag:

IT IS ORDERED, This 28th day of June, 1946, that the approval required by Sections 9 and 37 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808 and 835), of the sale of the S/S CITY OF OMAHA, Official No. 219515, to an alien as above set forth, with transfer to Honduran registry and flag, be, and it is hereby granted, upon the condition that there shall be no liens nor encumbrances on record against said vessel in the Customhouse at its last United States home port at the time its transfer to alien ownership, registry and flag is effected; and

IT IS ORDERED FURTHER, That this approval shall be null and void unless the sale alien and transfer to foreign registry and flag, hereby approved, are effected within six months of the date of such approval.
