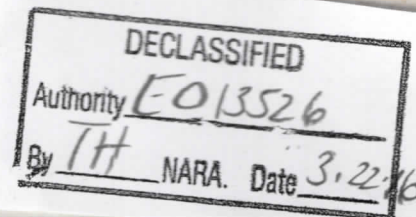

MEMORANDUM FOR THE CHAIRMAN OF THE CREW DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE,  
WAR SHIPPING ADMINISTRATION.

Information has been received by the Coast Guard from the Navy concerning Jerry Riney, wireless operator on the SS COCKEREL. It is reported that, in April, 1943, Riney was so drunk, he was unable to perform his duties and that he was insulting and belligerent and attempted to throw away the key to the radio room. His removal was requested by several shipmates.

No action will be taken in this case due to the fact that the vessel is Panamanian.
