1. The Panemanian S/S COLD HARBOR was inspected this date and the following armament was found on board:

GUNS AND AMMUNITION: 1 - 4" gun mk. IX mod. 5 - 1918, No. 745. Elevation 30° / 5°.

Arc of train 290°, telescopic sights. Located after end of poop deck.

SMALL ARMS AND AMMUNITION: 4-Lewis .30 machine guns. (Mounts: 2-wings of bridge, 2-aft boat deck).

MAGAZINE: Port side in lazeret space. Flooded by permanent flood line.

FIRE CONTROL AND COMMUNICATION: Telephone.

PERSONNEL: Sun's crew taken from ship's regular force.

MISCELLANEOUS: 1-ser. gas masks 4-bomb proof shelters, (2) wings of bridge, (2) boat deck; senerete slabs around bridge and redioroom; hull DeCaussed (wired).

- 2. It is the opinion of this office that the above-mentioned armament is carried for defensive purposes only, provided, that the vessel is employed in normal trade.
- 3. Inclosed herewith are two (2) photographs of this vessel, showing her guns and their location.
