Subject: Danish SS COLUMBIA; final disposition of.

1. The Danish SS COLUMBIA passed from the Custody of the Treasury Department to the U. S. Maritime Commission 1200 E.S.T. 12 July, 1941. The U. S. Maritime Commission chartered subject vessel to the United States Line who took custody 0001 E.S.T. 17 July. The Coast Guard guards were continued on board this vessel until 1600 E.S.T. 26 July, the date ship's crew reported aboard. Subject vessel changed to Panamanian registry, which was effected in New York, date of which is unknown. Subject vessel departed Baltimore 1730 E.S.T. 28 July for Norfolk, Virginia in ballast.
