Approving the Sale Alien and Transfer to Chinese Registry and Flag of the

St. Sc. COMET

WHEREAS, The United States Maritime Commission on March 16, 1948, authorized the sale of its steam screw COMET (ex-CAMDEN) former Official No. 204087, to Asia Development Corporation, a company established and existing under the laws of the Republic of China, with offices at 30 Shanse Road, Shanghai, China, with the privilege of transferring said vessel to foreign registry and flag:

IT IS ORDERED, This 31st day of March 1948, that the approval required by Section 9 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808), of the sale of the steam screw COMET (ex-CAMDEN), former Official No. 204087, to an alien as above set forth, with transfer to Chinese registry and flag, be, and it is hereby granted.

IT IS ORDERED FURTHER, that the approval hereby granted shall be null and void unless the sale alien and transfer to foreign registry and flag are effected within six months from March 16, 1948.
