Approving the Sale Alien and Transfer to Danish Registry and Flag of the Steam Screw Tanker COMET

WHEREAS, An application has been filed by Socony-Vacuum Oil Company, Inc., New York, N. Y., for the approval required by Sections 9 and 37 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808 and 835), of the sale of the steam screw tanker COMET, Official No. 230424, to Dampskibsselskabet of 1912 Aktieselskab and Aktieselskabet Dampskibsselskabet Svendborg, each a Danish corporation, with offices in Copenhagen, Denmark, and the transfer of said vessel to Danish registry and flag:

IT IS ORDERED, This 10th day of June 1947, that the approval required by Sections 9 and 37 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808 and 835), of the sale of the steam screw tanker COMET, Official No. 230424, to aliens as above set forth, with transfer to Danish registry and flag, be and it is hereby granted, upon the condition that there shall be no liens nor encumbrances on record against said vessel in the Customhouse at its last United States home port at the time its transfer to foreign ownership, registry and flag is effected; and

IT IS ORDERED FURTHER, That this approval shall be null and void unless the sale alien and transfer to foreign registry and flag, hereby approved, are effected within six months of the date of such approval.
