Paraphrase of radiogram from General Van Voorhis to Chief of Staff dated April 3, 1941:

From reliable information it has been learned that the Italian S.S. CONTE BIANCAMANO was sabotaged in a well concealed manner before it was seized. Inspection is under way and has already revealed the ruin of port high-pressure turbine bearings and blading. The Commanding General, Panama Canal Department will make a full report when inspection is completed. The crew of the S.S. CONTE BIANCAMANO is now under arrest, but the Commanding General strongly urges that it be sent to the United States on the U.S.A.T. LEONARD WOOD which sails from Cristobal at noon on April 4.
