TRANSFER ORDER NO. C-4739

Approving the Sale Alien and Transfer to
Chinese Registry and Flag of the S/S
CORDOVA

WHEREAS, An application has been filed by Alaska Steamship Company, Seattle, Washington, for the approval required by Sections 9 and 37 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808 and 835), of the sale of the steam screw CORDOVA, Official No. 209655, to "Lee Che Company", a Chinese corporation, of Shanghai, China, and the transfer of said vessel to Chinese registry and flag:

IT IS ORDERED, This 13th day of December, 1946, that the approval required by Sections 9 and 37 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808 and 835), of the sale of the steam screw CORDOVA, Official No. 209655, to an alien, as above set forth, with transfer to Chinese registry and flag, be, and it is hereby granted, upon the condition that there shall be no liens or encumbrances on record against said vessel in the Customhouse at its last United States home port at the time its transfer to foreign ownership, registry and flag is effected; and

IT IS ORDERED FURTHER, That this approval shall be null and void unless the sale alien and transfer to foreign registry and flag, hereby approved, are effected within six months of the date of such approval.
