TRANSFER ORDER NO. C-5399

Approving the Sale Alien and Transfer
to British Registry and Flag of the

E/S Tanker COTTONWOOD CREEK


WHEREAS, The United States Maritime Commission on April 8, 1947, authorized the sale of the electric screw Tanker COTTONWOOD CREEK, Official No. 246864, to British Tanker Company, Limited, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the Kingdom of Great Britain, with the privilege of transferring said vessel to foreign registry and flag:

IT IS ORDERED, This 2nd day of May, 1947, that the approval required by Sections 9 and 37 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808 and 835) of the sale of the electric screw Tanker COTTONWOOD CREEK, Official No. 246864, to an alien as above set forth, with transfer to British registry and flag, be, and it is hereby granted.
