MEMORANDUM FOR THE CHAIRMAN OF THE CREW DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE,
WAR SHIPPING ADMINISTRATION.

The Coast Guard has received reliable information relevant to the conduct of Hans G. Nielsen, oiler, while serving on the Panamanian vessel NV CUL-
PEPPER about August 1942. (Nielsen is now on the Panamanian SS EXTERMINATOR.)

Nielsen is reported to have attempted to incite a great deal of unrest and dissension among crew members and to have been neglectful of his duties.

No action will be instigated by the Coast Guard due to the fact this is a Panamanian vessel.
