MEMORANDUM FOR THE CHAIRMAN OF THE CREW DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE,
WAR SHIPPING ADMINISTRATION.

The Coast Guard has received information from a reliable source concerning Charles Derapelian, radio operator on the DANIEL CARROLL. It is alleged that Derapelian is incompetent to perform the duties of a radio operator. Report states that in one instance, during his recent service on the DANIEL CARROLL, he received an incoming radio message which he subsequently reported ^{with} 2 errors and one omission, and which, consequently, could not be decoded.

The Coast Guard will instigate whatever disciplinary action may be warranted in this case.
