Subj: SS DAVID GAILLARD, theft of Navy property, report on; forwarding of

1. F.B.I. report of 5 October, 1945, file 15-44, prepared by James C. Connors, may be obtained from F.B.I. Headquarters. Paragraph 1, Page 2, reads:

"This investigation (Theft from Interstate Shipment) is predicated upon a telephonic complaint received from Lieutenant Van Dyck Hubbard, U. S. Coast Guard Intelligence, Honolulu, T.H., who advised that the SS DAVID GAILLARD, with a merchant crew aboard, arrived at Pier Able-11, Pearl Harbor Navy Yard, on September 26, 1945, and Captain C. S. GRAHAM had reported the theft of watches and other jewelry from cargo aboard this ship while enroute from San Francisco to Honolulu."
