Charges:

Misconduct - 1 specification alleging unlawful pilfering of certain property from the cargo of the SS DAVID DAILLARD.

Pleas

Guilty.

Facts:

On 13 September, 1945, a group of crew members of the SS DAVID GAILLARD entered the Nos. 1 and 2 holds and pilfered certain articles. Subject was a member of the group, all of whom with the exception of one man, are quite young. Upon a rumor circulating the ship that the vessel would be searched, subject threw certain articles pilfered from the cargo over the side. It was evident to the Hearing Officer that in this particular case, Golden is not a criminal character and that the gravity of the episode was not fully understood.

Subject is registered with Local Board No. 2, Kilgore, Texas, Order No. 13133, Classification 2-B.

Conclusions:

The facts were sufficient to support the plea of guilty.

Findings:

Specification 1 proved by plea - Charge proved.

Order:

One year's suspension effective in continental United States, the last ten months of which are subject to two years' probation.

Appeal:

None indicated.
