1. A check of the crew list through the files of this office revealed Merchant Marine Personnel Circular No.86 lists GRAHAM, Robert C., Z-492520, and GUIOT, Louis, Z-200938 as wanted for hearing. Lieutenant R. E. KING, Merchant Marine Hearing Officer, Savannah, Georgia was notified of the SUBJECT's arrival at the port of Savannah, Georgia on 17 May, 1945.

2. The following seaman, who signed on Subject vessel at Leghorn, Italy, was interrogated and fingerprinted. Forms 2515 and 2765 are forwarded.

- (a) SCHULTZ, Benedict Joseph, born 8 June, 1925 at Minneapolis Minnesota; 5'6"; 150 pounds; brown eyes; black hair; issued Certificate of Identification, Z-495162, at New York on 23 December, 1943, and bears Sixth Naval District Security Indorsement dated 19 October, 1944; issued Duplicate Coast Guard Identification Card #031-138758 at New York on 28 June, 1944; U.S. Passport No.175249. SUBJECT sailed from Baltimore, Maryland on 20 February, 1945 as A.B. aboard the SS "AMASA DELANO" and was discharged at Leghorn, Italy on 4 April, 1945, for hospitalization. SUBJECT was a patient at the Army General Hospital, Leghorn, Italy, from 4 April, 1945 to 15 April, 1945. SUBJECT signed on the SS "DAVID L. YULEE" as A.B. on 18 April, 1945 at Leghorn, Italy, and arrived Savannah, Georgia
