MEMORANDUM FOR THE CHAIRMAN OF THE CREW DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE,
WAR SHIPPING ADMINISTRATION.

The Coast Guard has received from a reliable source information concerning Arthur A. Angelopoulos, AB aboard the SS DAVID STONE.

Report states that Angelopoulos was tried before a Summary Court Martial in Alexandria, Egypt, in July 1943, on a charge of violating the 96th Article of War.

The specification alleged that Angelopoulos was drunk and disorderly in quarters aboard the SS DAVID STONE about 16 June, 1943, in Alexandria, Egypt.

The accused was found guilty on the charge and specification and fined \$175.00.

The Coast Guard will instigate whatever further disciplinary action is warranted in this case.
