Approving the Redelivery to an Alien and Transfer to
Danish Registry and Flag of the
M. V. DAY STAR

WHEREAS, The War Shipping Administration, owner of the M.V. DAY STAR (ex-LAURA MAERSK), Official No. MC-1004, has requested the approval of the Maritime Commission, pursuant to Sections 9 and 37 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808 and 835), of the return of said vessel to "Dampskibsselskabet af 1912, Aktieselskab of Copenhagen, Denmark", and "Aktieselskabet Dampskibsselskabet Svendborg of Svendborg, Denmark", former owners, with transfer to Danish registry and flag:


IT IS ORDERED, This 11th day of July, 1946, that the approval required by Sections 9 and 37 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808 and 835), of the return of the M.V. DAY STAR (ex-LAURA MAERSK), Official No. MC-1004, to aliens as above set forth, with transfer to Danish registry and flag, be, and it is hereby granted; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That this approval shall be null and void unless the return to alien ownership and transfer to foreign registry, hereby approved, are effected within six months of the date of such approval.
