1. I am returning herewith your memorandum of July 18, 1943 relative to the boarding of the SS DEL SUD in New York Harbor on July 13, 1943. reported on 9 July, was given instructions on the 10th
 2. In line with our conversation, this matter was informally called to the attention of our New York office on July 20. That office advises that the boarding officer in question has had this matter called to his attention and now understands that interrogations conducted by him should not include any matter concerning the conduct of members of the U.S. Navy Armed Guards. (I was away at the time of the occurrence) this matter was not breached locally.
