One copy of the certificate supported with a complete muster roll is to be delivered to the ship's purser or Agent as authority to embark the passengers. The original Muster Roll showing the name, rate, and service number and in the case of civilians, the next of kin and address must be airmailed direct to the Bureau of Personnel immediately on departure. In case the vessel is lost, this is the official record from which the next of kin are notified. It is, therefore, essential that it be complete and correct in all respects. Two copies of the certificate must be mailed to the Port Director, NTS, Thirteenth Naval District, Exchange Building, Seattle, Washington, one of which will be turned over to the War Shipping Administration for their accounting purposes.
