Approving the Sale Alien and Transfer
to Honduran Registry and Flag of the

St. s. Cargo Vessel DOLLY MADISON

WHEREAS, The United States Maritime Commission on April 10, 1947, authorized the sale of its St.s. Cargo Vessel DOLLY MADISON, Official No. 243776, to Suwannee Fruit & Steamship Company, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Florida, with offices at Foot of Catherine Street, Jacksonville, Florida, with the privilege of transferring said vessel to Honduras Shipping Company, a Honduran corporation, and the transfer of said vessel to Honduran registry and flag:
