Subject vessel, of 1597 net tons, has been chartered by the Amtorg Trading Corp. (Russian). Loaded at Seattle 2200 tons of coal in bags for charterer's account for discharge at Nome, Alaska, and sailed from Seattle 16 September, 1941. According to the Master, Captain KRANTZ, the cargo is to be stored at Nome for the Russian Government as needed. The chief officer on board is Robert KAMDRON, an Estonian by birth and known locally as a Russian interpreter and navigator in Alaska and Siberia. According to KAMDRON it is rumored that the cargo may be transferred to a Russian vessel in the Bering Sea. It has also been rumored that the vessel may proceed direct to Siberia to discharge.
