MEMORANDUM FOR THE CHAIRMAN OF THE CREW DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE,
WAR SHIPPING ADMINISTRATION.

The Coast Guard has received information from a reliable source concerning Marion Luksa, formerly A.S. on the SS DOROTHY LUCKENBACH. Report states that Luksa refused to perform his duties on board this ship and attempted to induce other seamen to interfere with the proper operations of the vessel. Luksa was removed from his ship in Hobart, Tasmania, on July 8, 1943, and placed under arrest for the above offense.

The Coast Guard will instigate whatever disciplinary action is warranted in this case.
