FEDERAL AGENTS, INCLUDING THOSE OF ARMY AND NAVY INTELLIGENCE AND THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, SWARMED ABOARD THE LINER AND PERMITTED ONLY DIPLOMATIC ATTACHES TO LEAVE THE VESSEL IMMEDIATELY.

FOUR HOURS AFTER THE VESSEL DOCKED THE BULK OF THE PASSENGERS WERE BEING QUESTIONED BY THE AGENTS. THE DIPLOMATS AND THEIR FAMILIES LEFT THE PIER AS SOON AS THEY WERE PERMITTED OFF THE SHIP.
