6026 AT 0800 OCTOBER 24 UNIDENTIFIED PLANE CIRCLED SWEDISH SS  
DROTTHINGHOLM BOUND WEST ABOUT 2 MILES FROM NANTUCKET LS AND  
DISAPPEARED ON SOUTHEASTERLY COURSE X NANTUCKET UNABLE DETERMINE  
FROM WHICH DIRECTION PLANE APPROACHED X ARMY ACCOUNTS FOR COMMERCIAL  
AND ARMY PLANES AND NO NAVY PLANES FROM LAND BASES IN THAT POSITION  
X OPERATIONS FIRST NAVDIST SUGGESTS POSSIBLY CATIPULTED PLANE FROM  
QUINCY VINCENNES OR WICHITA OF PATROL 9 X SUGGEST HEADQUARTERS  
CHECK WITH NAVAL OPERATIONS REGARDING THIS POSSIBILITY AND YORKDIST
