Paraphrase of telegram received from the American Consul at Goteborg, Sweden, dated October 13, 9 a.m.

The steamship <u>Drottningholm</u> sailed for New York this morning (October 13) carrying 692 passengers of whom 292 were American citizens. 850 passengers had been counted on by the steamship officials and the difference in the number booked would seem to indicated that repatriation of citizens wishing to return to the United States is practically completed.
