1. The American Tanker "E.R.KEMP".
(insert name and nationality of belligerent)
was inspected this date and the following armament was found on board:

GUNS: One 4" 50 Cal. Placed aft on a Platform.

AMMUNITION: 85 Rds 4" 50 Cal. Armor piercing.

SMALL ARMS: Two 30 Cal Browning Machine Guns, placed on top of the Pilot House one on each side. Four 45 Cal Automatic Pistols.

AMMUNITION: 2850 Rds 30 Cal Machine Gun, 200 Rds 45 Cal Pistol.

MAGAZINE: Aft below decks on Port side.

FIRE CONTROL AND COMMUNICATION EQUIPMENT: Sprinkler system. Telephones from Gun deck aft to the Bridge and on top of the Pilot House.

GUNS CREWS: Eight men in Gun Crew, Coxswain in charge and seven AS.

REMARKS: Vessel is Degaused, has placement for two anti-aircraft Guns at the break of the Poop deck one on each side, has one U.S.Navy Signal man onboard Sea 2/c.
