1. The American Tanker "E.R.KEMP".

was inspected this date and the following armament was found on board:

GUNS: One Four Inch 50 Cal. Placed aft on a Platform.

AMMUNITION: 93 Rds 4" 50 Cal Armor piercing.

SMALL ARMS: Two Browning 30 Cal Machine Guns. Placed above the Pilot House
one on each side. Four Pistols 45 Cal.

AMMUNITION: 2850 Rds 30 Cal Browning Machine Gun. 200 Rds Pistol 45 Cal.

MAGAZINE: Aft below decks on Port side.

FIRE CONTROL AND COMMUNICATION EQUIPMENT: Sprinkler system. Four telephones
from Gun deck aft to the top of the Pilot House and inside the Pilot House.

GUNS CREWS: Eight men in the Gun crew, Coxswain in charge and seven AS.

REMARKS: Vessel is Degaused, has placement for two Machine Guns at the
break of the Poop deck, one on each side. Carries one USN Signal Man Sea 2/c
