ITINERARY: Arrived Charleston from New York, 10 June, 1945.

1. The crew list was checked thru the files of this office and revealed the following information:

MENONI, Guilio, listed on MMSL, 1 September, 1944. "Z-69771, E-166256, (Temp. Z-11965), SS 060-16-2903, 5'6", 154#, blk. hr., br. eyes, lt. comp., born 6 September, 1891, Italy, Messman, SS CHAS FOLGER, March, 1943, SS DORCHESTER, 9 March, 1942. Rptd. Fascist in contact with German Consulate, NYC German Embassy in Lisbon and Ger. Consulate in Hoboken, N. J. in 1941."

MENONI, Guilio, Messman, aboard SUBJECT vessel, was interviewed and is identical with Subject of above information. MENONI advised that he had been interviewed regarding this information a number of times before; that he had been aboard the SS CHAS FOLGER, and SS DORCHESTER, on the specified dates; that he had been in Lisbon and Germany but denied contacting the German consulate in any city at any time. MENONI produced his maritime documents and they were found endorsed in 3ND, 10 August, 1944. MENONI had in his possession the following maritime documents:

2. QUELLETTE, Joseph E., Z-232961, listed on Merchant Marine Personnel Circular, Number 88, as "wanted for hearing". Officer-in-Charge, Merchant Marine Hearing Unit, Charleston, S. C., was made cognizant.
