MEMORANDUM FOR THE CHAIRMAN OF THE CREW DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE,
WAR SHIPPING ADMINISTRATION.

The Coast Guard has received information from a reliable source concerning Louie Strand, A.B. on the SS ELIJAH WHITE. Report alleges that Strand, on 29 September, 1943, used abusive language to the Master of his vessel. On a later date he refused to comply with the Master's order to report to the Master's Cabin.

The Coast Guard will instigate whatever disciplinary action is warranted in this case.
