MEMORANDUM FOR THE CHAIRMAN OF THE CREW DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE,
WAR SHIPPING ADMINISTRATION

The Coast Guard has received information from a reliable source concerning Antonio Arrieta, 2nd cook, on the ENOCH TRAIN during a recently completed voyage.

Report alleges that Arrieta consistently violated blackout regulations. It is stated that he kept his porthole open so frequently at restricted hours that on 9 February, 1944 it was chained down to eliminate further violations.

The Coast Guard will instigate whatever disciplinary action is warranted in this case.
