SUAREZ, Manuel, Z-161598, A.B. aboard Subject vessel apparently is not the same person as he holds Social Security Number 091-14-3736 dated 17 January, 1940, born 9 July, 1894 at Coruna, Spain and claims never to have sailed aboard SS "ESSO CHARLESTON"; holds U.S. Passport #95853 dated 8 April, 1943; New York COTP #63762; previously employed by Federal Shipyard, Kearney, New Jersey., Julius Meat Packing Company, New York City, and presently by the Isthmian Steamship Company aboard Subject vessel.
