Arc of train 360°. Telescopic sights. Located special raised platform after end of poop deck.

SMALL ARMS AND AMMUNITION: 4-Lewis .30 machine guns. (Mounts: 2-wings of bridge, 2-poop deck). 1-Smith and Wesson .38 pistol. 15-rds pistol ammunition.

MAGAZINE: Port side in lazaret space. Flooded by hose only.

FIRE CONTROL AND COMMUNICATION: Telephone.

PERSONNEL: Taken from ship's regular force.

MISCELLANEOUS: 1-Buoy; 4-bomb proof shelters, (2) wings of bridge, (2) poop deck; armor plate around bridge and radioroom; hull DeGaussed (wired).

2. It is the opinion of this office that the above-mentioned armament is carried for defensive purposes only, provided the vessel is employed in normal trade.
