HAVANA, Cuba, March 11 (UP)
—The tanker reported ~~towed into~~
Guantanamo Naval Station by
United States warships after being
damaged by U-boat shellfire was
identified today as the 10,389-ton
Esso Belivar, operated under Pana-
manian registry by the Panama
Transport Company.
The newspaper Crisol, reporting
arrival of the tanker yesterday,
said the submarine that attacked
it was sunk by United States
planes.
