Commander F. P. Dillon:

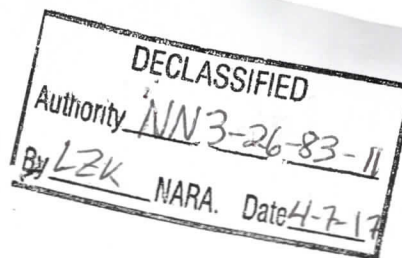
The following quotation from a boarding report dated 13 August, 1942, is forwarded for your information:

"Chief Mate R. H. Rasmussen of the 'ESSO CHARLESTON' said that on the trip north from Cape Henry, they passed a number of various type buoys that did not appear on the chart. He believes that an effort should be made to have new charts issued as soon as possible, because these unmarked buoys cause considerable confusion and anxiety, as their purpose may be to mark wrecks, shoals, etc."
