1. DCGIO, 6ND advised by Dispatch 021540 that Ernest LOTTI, Z-123287, F/WT, was listed on the Merchant Marine Suspect List. The vessel departed before LOTTI could be interviewed and DCGO, 5ND was so advised by dispatch.
2. John PUCCI, Chief Mate, holds Z-D-1-70315 issued 3 August, 1942 at New York City. PUCCI states that he lost his original papers in July, 1942 while traveling on a train from Baltimore to New York.
3. Harry WHITBY, British, Z-235007, Boatswain, holds Canadian Passport 184428 showing an American Visa dated 6 February, 1942. WHITBY was born in Liverpool, England on 8 July, 1907.
4. Raymond WALLACE, Oiler, holds Z-D-2-246402 issued 30 March, 1942 at New York, and possesses United States Passport issued 14 February, 1943. WALLACE states that his original papers were stolen from him in 1941 in Panama, and that the second set of papers were lost aboard the SS COLLOMER when that vessel was torpedoed in March, 1942 in the North Atlantic.
5. Eric Robert BROHIER, age 18, British, Z-249674, Wiper, holds British Passport showing that he was born in India. He is a non resident alien and has a clear record with the Immigration Authorities in Jacksonville.
6. Roland BARD, French, Z-409315, Chief Steward, holds Certificate
