1. Subject vessel departed Casablanca, Fr. Mor. 19 Oct 43.
2. The following workaway passengers were paneled at INS Barge Office.

DOLPHY, Gladstone - Colored - U.S. - Steward - age 33 - Z # 61092 issued N.Y. 22 Sep 37 - Home address, 723 St. Nicholas Ave., N.Y.C. Subject stated he departed N.Y. on the SS CARDINAL GIBBONS 20 Jul 43; that he was beached for 60 days at C.G. hearing at Casablanca 21 Sep 43 on charges growing out of a fight and refusal to quit fighting and return to his quarters. Subject was repatriated as a workaway on subject vessel. Subject is identical with subject of reference (a) which states operators of Grace Line consider subject undesirable.

SHIVERS, Walter Frederick Jr. - U.S. - A.B. - age 40 - Z#233205 issued N.Y. 6 Oct 41 - Home address, 31 Park Ave., N.Y.C. Subject stated he departed N.Y. on the SS BENJAMIN R. MILAM on 13 Sep 43. Subject was beached and suspended for 60 days at Casablanca at a Coast Guard hearing in Oct 43, growing out of charges that subject smoked at wheel, left watch without being properly secured, and failed to turn to when called for watch.

3. Coast Guard Hearing Unit was informed of the arrival of both workaways, and both were remanded to G.G. Officer.
4. Search of DIO 3ND Central Files was negative, except for ref. (a).
5. Both passengers were released by Travel Security.
