## Summary of Information:

It is reported that the following members of the crew of the Latvian SS EVERASIA are most "Bolshevik":

Chief Officer	Sergejs Bole
Third Engineer	Valdemars Valkovics
Radio Operator	Zigfrids Knotin
Seaman	Valdemars Tenbergs

The SS EVERASIA arrived at New York on 24 November, 1940, from St. John, New Brunswick, in ballast, and is expected to sail in the near future for Hampton Roads, Virginia.

The agents for the vessel, Thor Eckert Company of 17 Battery Place, New York City, have indicated that it is their intention to exchange the crews of the SS EVERASIA and the SS EVERASIA, another Latvian vessel now laid up in New York, because of an internal dispute concerning crew wages on the SS EVERASIA.
