MEMORANDUM FOR THE CHAIRMAN OF THE CREW DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE,
WAR SHIPPING ADMINISTRATION.

The Coast Guard has received information from a reliable source concerning the conduct of Victor C. Archer, O.S., during April 1943, while serving on the F. MARION CRAWFORD. Archer on one specific occasion, while at the helm of the vessel, is reported to have deliberately changed the course contrary to orders. He is reported to have slept on watch, to have refused to obey orders, and to have neglected to perform his duty.

Action, if indicated, will be instigated by the Coast Guard.
