The Coast Guard has received information from a reliable source concerning Harold Irving Nelson, formerly an oiler on the SS FAIRLAND. Report states Nelson missed his ship in Montevideo, about May 1943, due to the fact he was involved in a fight ashore and sentenced to jail.

The Coast Guard will instigate whatever disciplinary action is warranted in this case.
