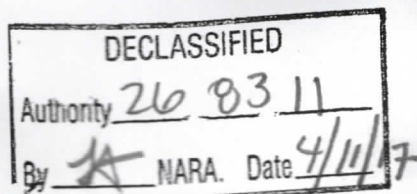

Supplementing paragraph C of the memorandum of 1 July 1942 concerning crew trouble aboard the SS FARIDA at Pensacola, Florida, it has been ascertained that VAINO KARTANO was the chief engineer who led the demands against the master. VIANA KIRPPU is the crew member who jumped overboard but was later returned to the ship at New Orleans.

The Seaman's Records and Welfare Unit of the Coast Guard and the War Shipping Administration are unable to furnish the name of the master of the SS FARIDA when the above-mentioned incident occurred. The J. H. Winchester Co., 17 Battery Place, New York, are the agents for the FARIDA and will probably furnish the Coast Guard with the master's name if desired.
