1. The subject vessel is owned by the Koppers Coal Company and registered at Baltimore, Maryland, under date of 25 January 1940. This vessel is operated by Mystic Steamship Company, and charter dated 14 May 1940 shows the Nitrate Corporation of Chile Limited, an English firm, to be the charterers for current voyage to take a load of nitrate from Tocopilla, Chile, to Savannah, Georgia.

2. This vessel had aboard a cargo of 8394 tons of coal when entering this port on 22 May 1940 and departed the same day for Tocopilla, Chile, after taking aboard bunkers. The radio was sealed upon arrival.
