1. The was inspected this date and the following armament was found on board:

GUNS AND AMMUNITION: 1 - 3" mark III model 4, 1906. No. 570. Elevation 30° + 10°. Are of train 360°. Telescopic sights. Located on a special raised platform aft end poop deck. 49-rds fixed ammunition.

**MALL ARMS AND AMMUNITION: 2-Hotchkiss .303 machine guns; 2-Colt .50 machine guns; 4-machine gun mounts located two on wings of bridge and two on the boat deck; 1-Lee Enfield rifle .303; 1750-rds .50; 1300-rds .303;

MAGAZINE: Port side aft in steering flats. Flooded by a sprinkler system.

FIRE CONTROL AND COMMUNICATION: Telephone. 1-Aldis (day) lamo.

PERSONNEL: 1-Gun layer (Ex. Norwegian Navy); balance of gun's crew taken from ship's regular force; 2-certified merchant navy defense officers on board.

MISCELLANEOUS: 6-smoke floats and 6-igniters; 14-steel helmets; 32-civilian duty gas masks; 1-zig-zag clock; 2-P.A.C. projectors, 4-rockets and 4-fouling cables; 32-decontamination sets; 1-convoy light and 1-convoy buoy; 3-kites flown from the mainmast; 4-bomb-proof shelters located two on wings of bridge and two on aft boat deck; concrete slabs around the bridge and radio room for protection; DeCaussed (wired).

- 2. It is the opinion of this office that the above-mentioned armament is carried for defensive purposes only, provided, that the vessel is employed in normal trade.
- 3. Inclosed herewith are two (2) photographs of this vessel, showing her guns and their location.
