MEMORANDUM FOR COMMANDER POLLIO

Subj: FIRE ISLAND damaged in collision with Canadian SS QUEENS PARK,
off New York Harbor, 15 July, 1944

1. Counsel for the QUEENS PARK have denied liability for the above mentioned collision and it appears necessary to institute civil proceedings in an effort to recover the damages sustained by the Coast Guard vessel. These damages are presently estimated to exceed \$10,000.
2. Can you ascertain and advise me when and where the Canadian SS QUEENS PARK will next return to an American port.
