Summary of Information:

The following information with reference to subject vessel is forwarded as being of interest:

On April 11, 1942 about 1:45 P. M. the motor launch No. Q-11 passed upstream abeam of the Florida at New Orleans, and one of the occupants was seen to take pictures of the vessel. The fire guard, one Henry Mabne, notified the military police on board the vessel, who in turn notified a Coast Guard vessel nearby. The Q-11 was overhauled, was boarded by the military police and the occupants, a man and a woman were placed under arrest and the camera confiscated.
