Modification of Approval of Sale Alien and Transfer to Foreign Registry and Flag of the Undocumented Liberty Type Vessel FORT ELLICE

WHEREAS, By its Transfer Order No. C-6137, dated March 24, 1948, the Maritime Commission, approved, pursuant to Section 9 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808), of the sale of its undocumented Liberty Type vessel FORT ELLICE to Ardeshir Hormusji Bhiwandiwalla and Company, a partnership organized and existing under the laws of The Government of India, with the privilege of transferring said vessel to Indian registry and flag; and

WHEREAS, a request has now been received for a modification of the above so as to approve the transfer of said vessel to British registry and flag in lieu of Indian registry and flag:

IT IS ORDERED, This 4th day of May 1948, that Transfer Order No. C-6137, dated March 24, 1948, be, and it is hereby modified so as to approve the transfer of the undocumented vessel FORT ELLICE to British registry and flag, in lieu of Indian registry and flag, all other terms and conditions of the Commission's Transfer Order No. C-6137 to remain unchanged.
