to Italian Registry and Flag of the

E/S Tanker FORT ERIE

WHEREAS, The United States Maritime Commission on October 24, 1947, authorized the sale of its E/S tanker FORT ERIE, Official No. 244060, to the Government of Italy, with the privilege of transferring said vessel to foreign registry and flag:


IT IS ORDERED, This 13th day of April 1948 that the approval required by Section 9 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808), of the sale of the E/S tanker FORT ERIE, Official No. 244060, to an alien as above set forth, with transfer to Italian registry and flag, be, and it is hereby granted.
