Summary of Information:

1. The following which is the substance of a report from the District Coast Guard Officer, 11ND, dated 23 May, 1942 is forwarded as of interest.

Man named David GUNINE got by Pinkerton guards on Pier 1, Berth 50 (Long Beach) posing as crew member of the SS FORT FRASER. He was apprehended near that vessel and is now being held by Long Beach police for investigation. He is said to have a long criminal record. The Captain of the Port of Los Angeles is taking action in regard to negligence on the part of Pinkerton guards and inadequate guarding of local port facilities.
