Subj: SS FORT WINNEBAGO; charge of homicide against seaman

1. It is reported at Headquarters that Manuel Pasqual Fabay, Z-417247, Chief Cook of subject vessel, has been taken into custody by Naval authorities at Saipan and is being transported to the United States on the USS BOLIVAR.
2. Fabay appears to have killed Augusta Hal Beard, Z-698157, Utilityman, on the vessel indicated, on or about 6 November, 1945, and the Department of Justice has been duly notified of the matter.
3. The witnesses for the trial of Fabay are on board the SS FORT WINNEBAGO which is expected to arrive at San Pedro on 29 November. The USS BOLIVAR is also expected to arrive at that port on the same date.
4. Since no further information than that above indicated is at present available, it is requested that Headquarters be supplied with a report in detail of the circumstances attending subject incident.
